Date	Webinar	Focus Audience	Descriptions
Oct 26	Reevaluation Steps	School Psychologists, Gifted Support Teachers (especially high school), LEAs	As school districts make enrichment and acceleration for all a higher priority, the need for a GIEP may begin to wane. This session will review some recommended steps a district should consider before embarking on a large-scale reevaluation process for multiple students.
Nov 16	Determining Instructional Levels	Teachers, Building level administrator, curriculum	The key to determining the intensity of need is how discrepant the student is from the level of instruction s/he is receiving. Organizing all of that information can be daunting. This session will review the Data Template, a tool to help drive the collection and analysis process for determining instructional levels.
Jan 25	What Parents should learn from the Gifted Written Report	Parents, School Psychologists, Teachers	The Gifted Written Report will be unpacked during this webinar so parents become familiar with the type of information they should see in the document as a result of the Comprehensive Evaluation.
Feb 22	Top Ten Things Administrators Should know about Gifted Ed in PA	Building and District Level Administrators	Administrators have many initiatives on their plate and so this brief webinar is meant to highlight the most important points about gifted education that they need to know.
Mar 22	Notice of Recommended Assignment - Timelines	Gifted Support Teachers, LEAs, Parents, School Psychologists	The GIEP alone is not a legally binding document until agreement is noted on the Notice of Recommended Assignment and signed by the district and parents. Timelines around Evaluation and GIEP events can be confusing. This session will review timelines and responsibilities.
Apr 26	Lessons from the research	All Stakeholders	The focus for training and professional development has often been around how to complete the forms, meanwhile research continues about how best to meet the needs of students identified as gifted. This session will highlight some current ideas in the research (as well as a few that continue to be applicable).
